

# STAND-UP ST. NICHOLAS

## MATERIALS:

White lightweight poster board or cardstock  
Pink, yellow, red, and white construction or fadeless paper  
Black fine-point marker or pen  
Craft glue or roll-on dry adhesive  
Clear tape

## EQUIPMENT:

Scissors  
12-inch ruler

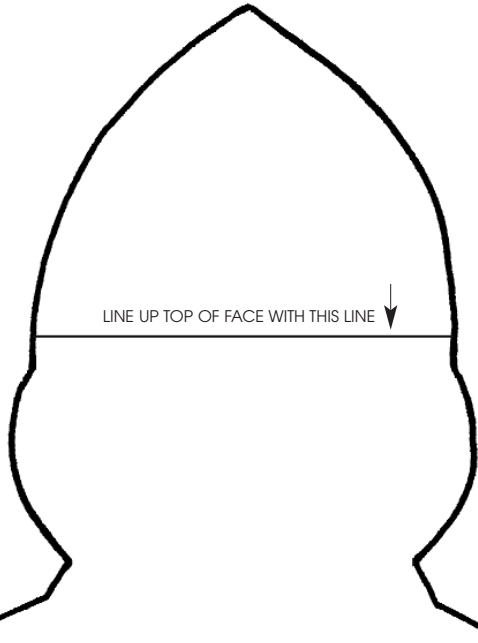
## DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut whole background pattern out of white poster board.  
You will glue individual pieces onto this basic shape.
2. Fold each side at dashed fold line. Fold the front section forward, using a ruler as a guide to make a sharp straight crease. Then turn it over and use the ruler again to fold the same section back. This makes a nice sharp crease (it goes to the back). Do this to the other side also. Crease the fold well.
3. Cut out pink face, pink hands, white beard and mustache, red miter (hat), 2 red cope (cloak) pieces, yellow cross, and yellow crozier. The dashed line on the head is the cutting line for the pink face.
4. Color shoes with black marker.
5. Glue pieces to background in the following order:
  - (a) face
  - (b) cope pieces (put glue only on the edge that goes near the center, leaving outside edge free)
  - (c) beard
  - (d) mustache
  - (e) miter
  - (f) crossLet dry. Then glue crozier in position as in photo. Glue hands, one hand over crozier and other hand in position next to it. Let dry.
6. Fold back creased white sides until they meet in the back forming a triangular shape. Tape center back together in at least three places so it will stand up.

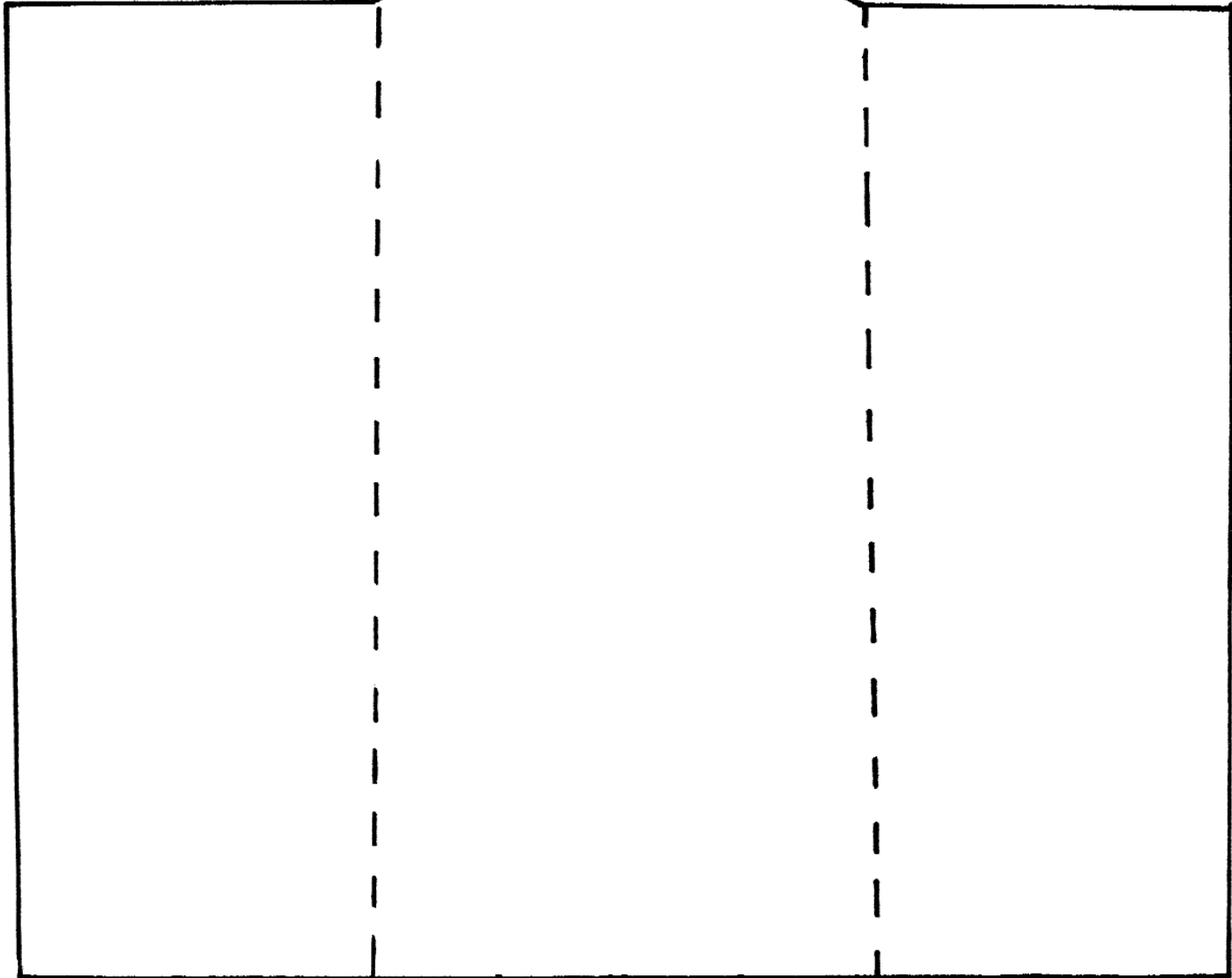

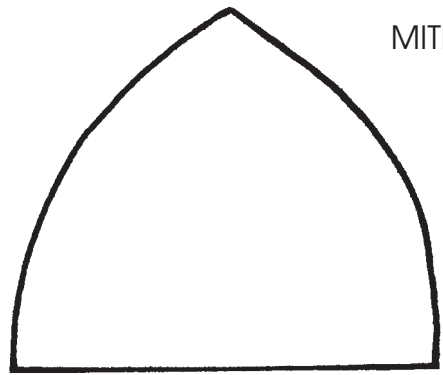

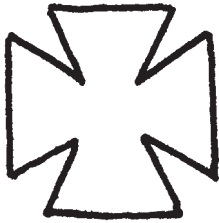

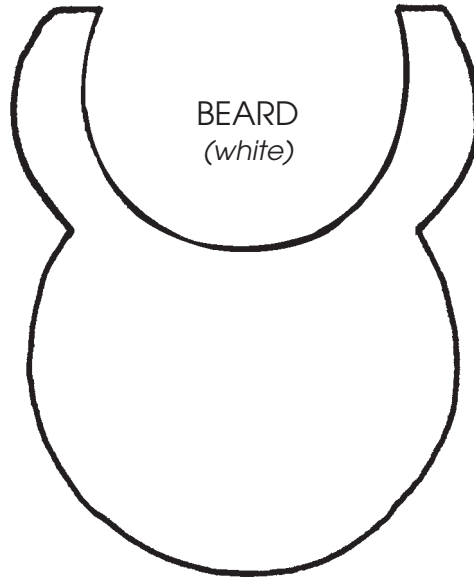

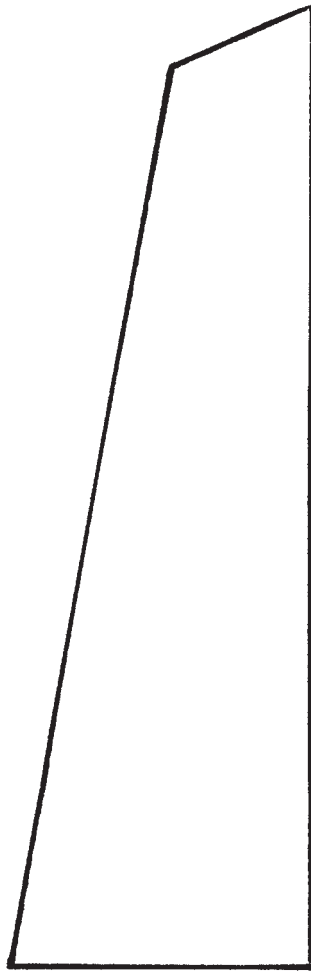

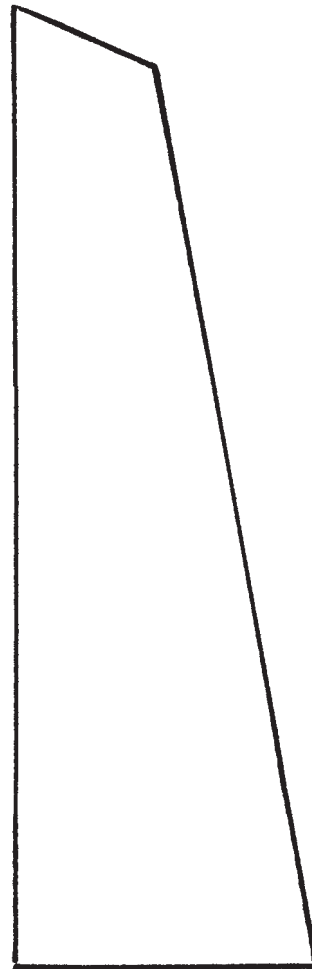
