Eleventh Day of Christmas

Second Day of Christmas

Third Day of Christmas

READ: . . . from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to the town of Bethlehem in Judea. *Luke 2.4*

SING: O little town of Bethlehem,
 How still we see thee lie
Above thy deep and dreamless sleep
 The silent stars ,go by;
Yet in thy dark streets shineth
 The everlasting Light;
The hopes and fears of all the years
 Are met in thee tonight.

Fourth Day of Christmas

READ: Mary was pregnant, and while they were in Bethlehem, the time came for her to have her baby. She gave birth to her first son, wrapped him in: cloths and laid him in a manger--there was no room for them to stay in the inn. *Luke 2:6 7*

SING: Away in a manger, no crib for his bed,
The little Lord Jesus laid down his sweet head;
The stars in the sky looked down where he lay,
The little Lord Jesus, asleep on the hay.

Fifth Day of Christmas

READ: There were some shepherds in that part of the country
who were spending the night in the fields, taking care
of their flocks, *Luke 2:8*

SING: While shepherds watched their flocks by night,
All seated on the ground,
The angel of the Lord came down,
And glory shone around.
'Fear not,' said he, for mighty dread
Had seized their troubled mind;
'Glad tidings of great joy I bring,
To you and all mankind.'

Sixth Day of Christmas

READ: An angel of the Lord appeared to them; and the glory
of the Lord shone over them. They were terribly
afraid.. *Luke 2:9*

Seventh Day of Christmas

you, which will bring great joy to all the people. This
very day in David's town your Savior was
born—Christ the Lord!" *Luke 2.10, 11*

'Glory to the newborn King;

God and sinners reconciled!'

'Christ is born in Bethlehem.'

Eighth Day of Christmas

READ: "And this is what will prove it to you; you will find a
baby wrapped in cloths and lying In a manger.'
Luke 2:12

SING: Silent night, holy night,

Sleep in heavenly peace,

Ninth Day of Christmas

READ: Suddenly a great army of heaven's angels appeared

Luke 2.13,14

READ: When the angels went away from them back into
heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to
Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened,
which the Lord has told us." So they hurried off and
found Mary and Joseph and saw the baby lying in the
manger. *Luke 2.15,16*
