

WOODEN SHOE

MATERIALS

Tan or brown construction paper, trimmed to go through printer

PREPARATION

Print pattern on brown paper, one for each child

EQUIPMENT

Scissors

Roll-on adhesive, glue or stapler



DIRECTIONS

1. Write child's name in the center rectangle on both sides of the paper (the name will be visible no matter how the shoe is folded).
2. Cut out on outer black lines.
3. Cut the two solid lines at the end to make three flaps, cut ONLY as far as the dashed lines (this will form the heel).
4. Fold and crease along all dashed lines.
5. To form the heel (three flaps), fold up the center flap, glue the side flaps inside the center flap. This creates a box-like heel.
6. The single flap makes the toe; fold the toe flap up toward the heel.
7. Bring left and right corners over the center toe flap; glue in place, staple for secure closure.
8. Fill shoes with traditional Saint Nicholas treats: candy cane, clementine or tangerine, walnuts and gold coins.
