

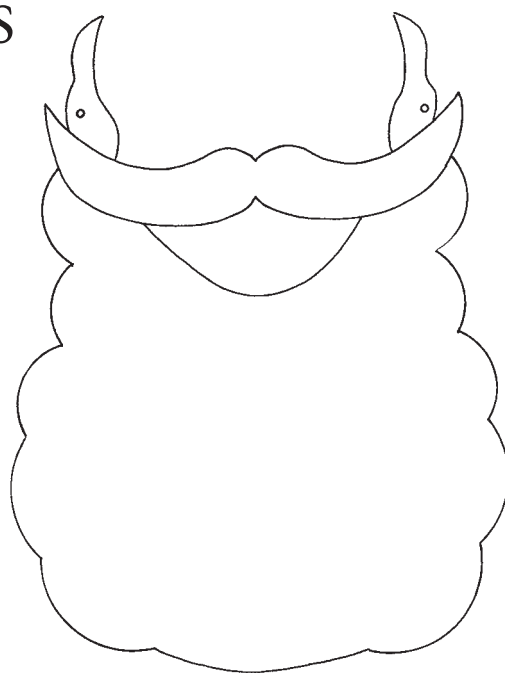
DRESS UP AS ST. NICHOLAS

MATERIALS:

Yellow (or gold) and white poster board
Red construction or fadeless paper
2 yards of red material
1 yard 1/2-inch ribbon
1 x 36-inch wooden dowel (for crozier)
1 yard of string or yarn (for beard ties)
Glue

EQUIPMENT:

Small paper punch
Scissors
Stapler



Example of costume for face.

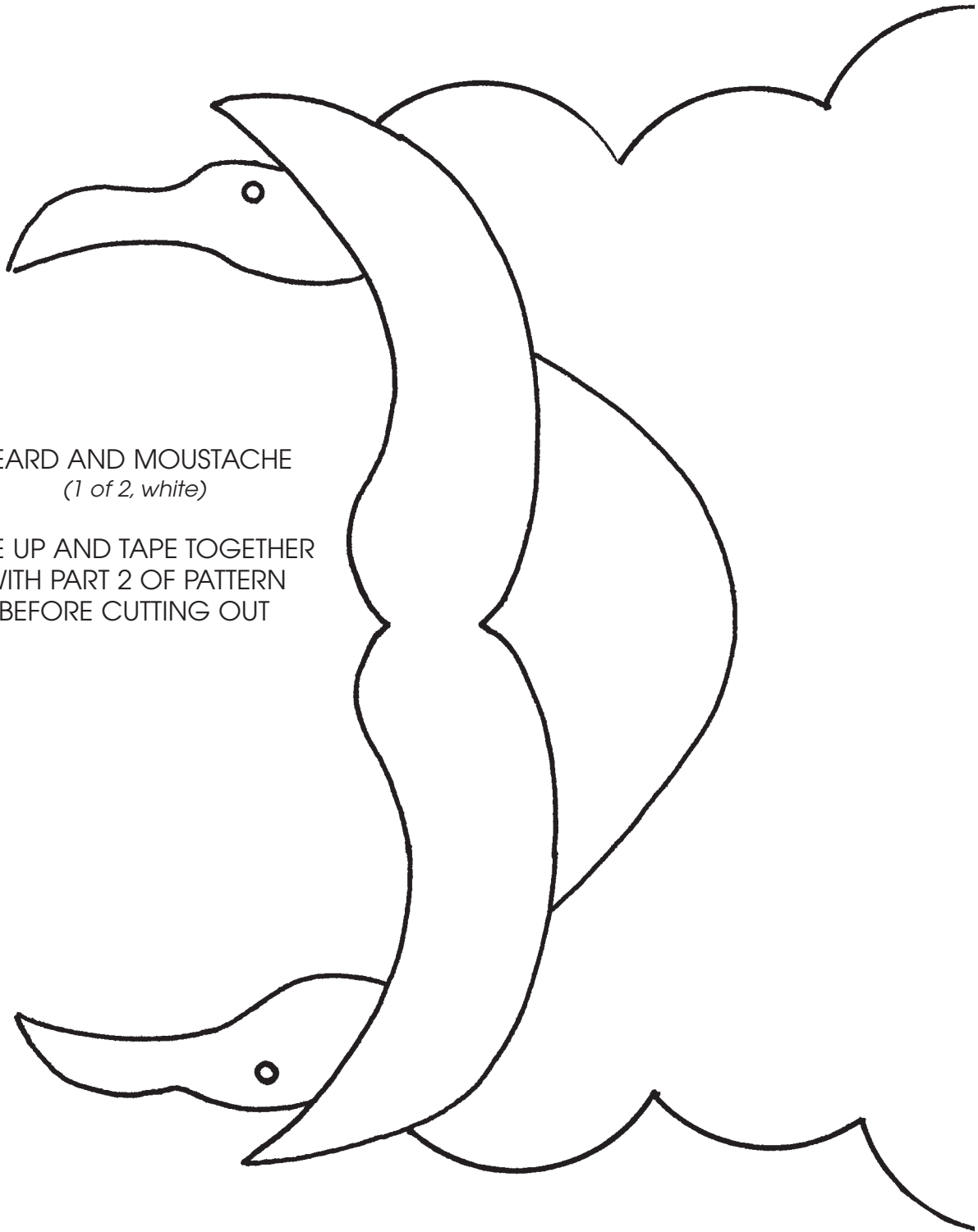
DIRECTIONS: *(Enlarge patterns if needed)*

1. Cut miter (hat) pattern out of yellow/gold poster board. Cut a head band out of the poster board about 1 1/2 inches wide and long enough to go around head, plus some. Fit it to head and staple band together.
2. Cut inner pattern of miter out of red construction or fadeless paper. Cut the cross area out of the red paper (or cut cross out of yellow paper and glue on). Glue the red piece to the miter base, letting the gold show through the cut-out cross.
3. Glue or staple miter onto band.
4. Cut beard and hair from white poster board. With small punch, make a hole on each side (as designated on pattern) for string to tie around head. Attach string long enough to go over ears and tie at back of head.
5. Cut top of crozier (staff) out of yellow or gold poster board. Tape around wooden dowel near top.
6. Cape: Take 2 yards of red material and fold in half, as in diagram #1. Then form a triangle, as in diagram #2. Cut on neck line and bottom cut line, as in diagram #3. This will form a half circle.
7. Cut ribbon piece in half and bar tack (sew) each piece to either side of neck line, as in diagram #4.
8. An alternative to this cape would be a red bath towel.

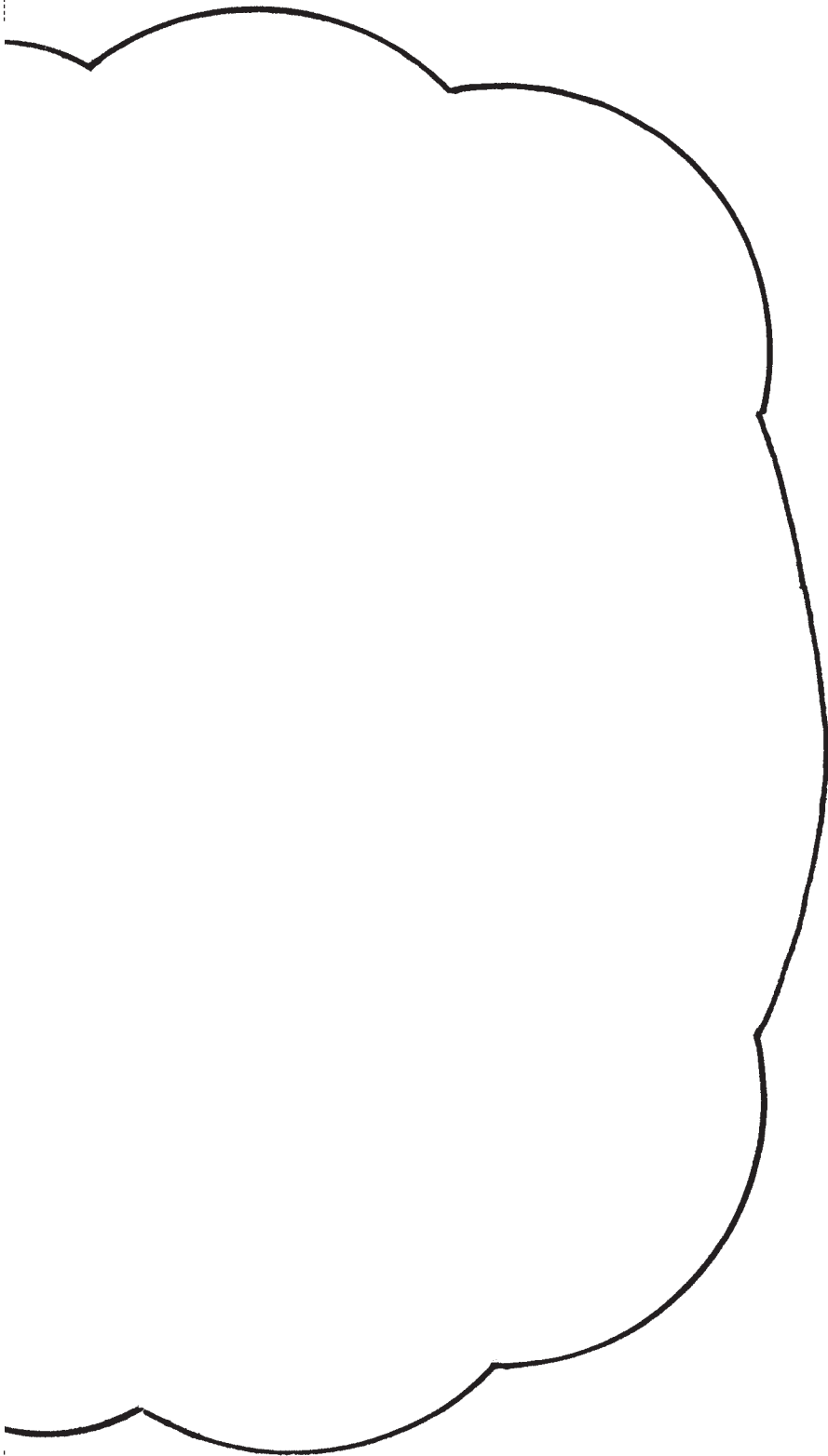

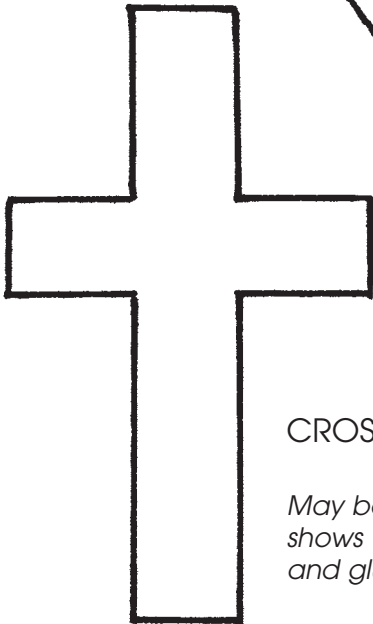

CROSS (CUT 2)

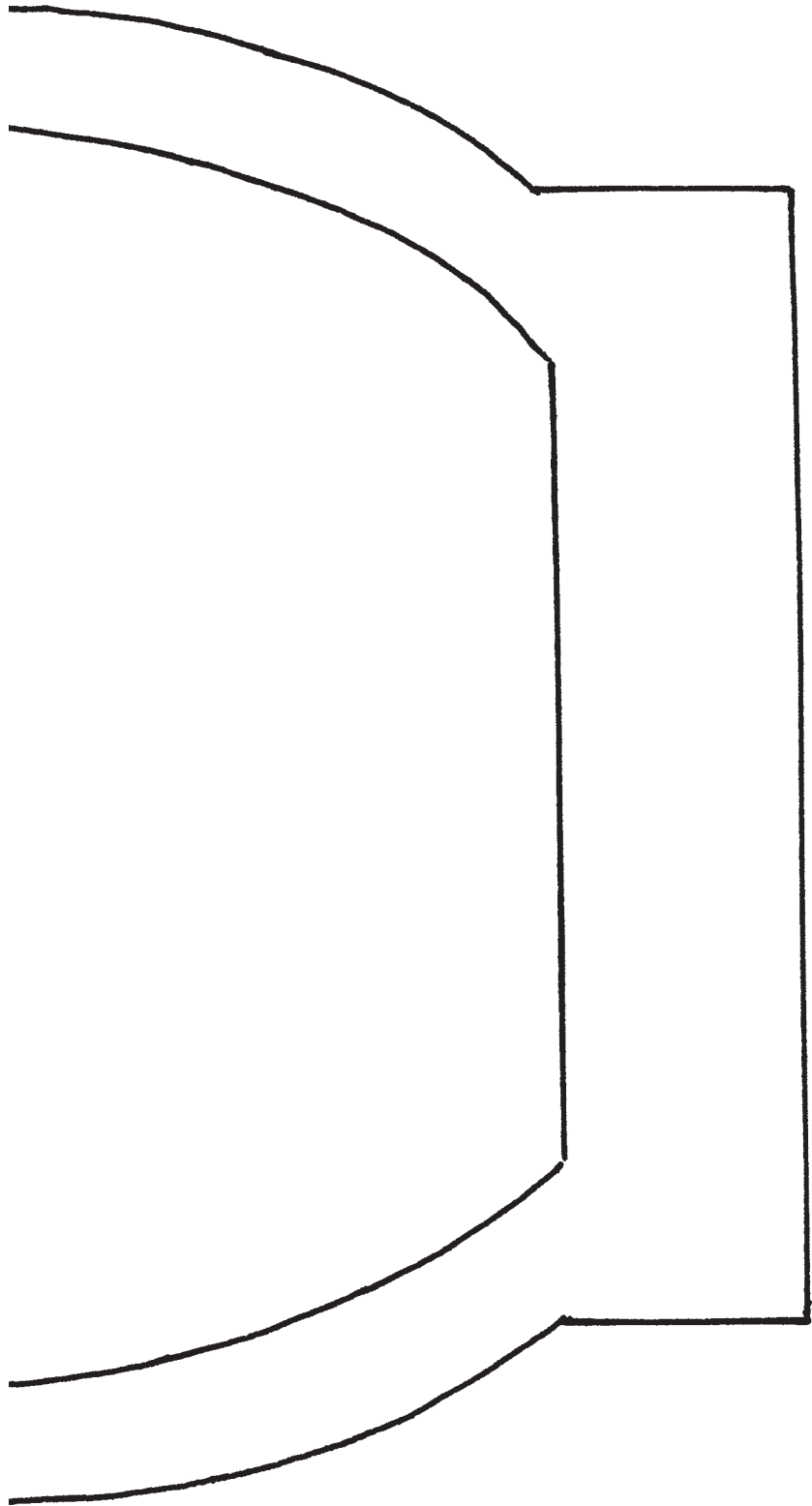
*May be cut out of miter so backing

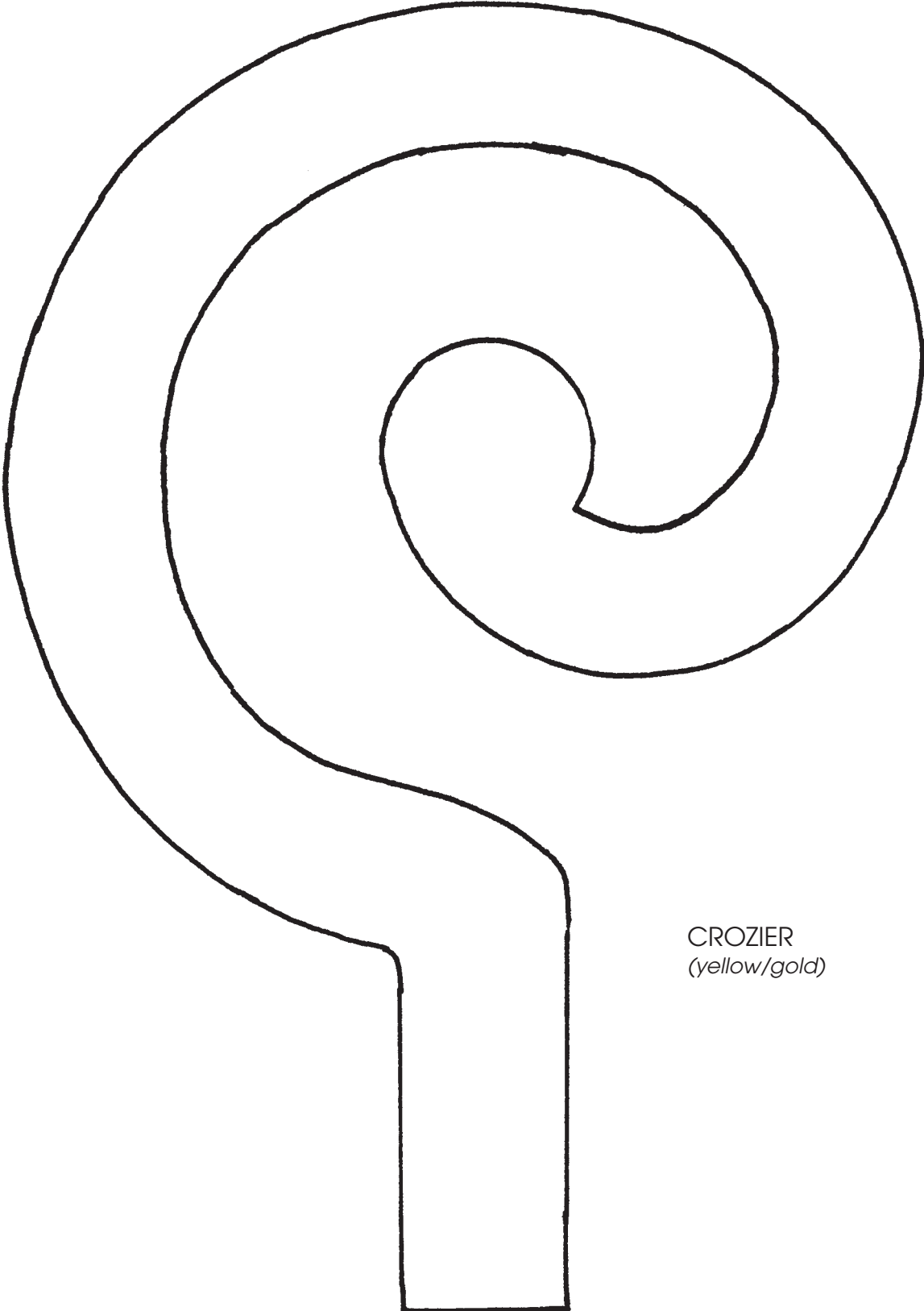

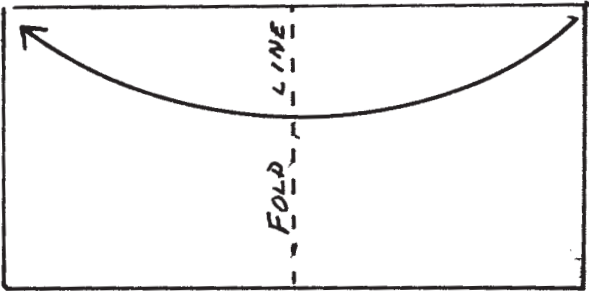

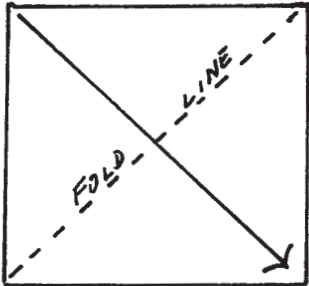
CROZIER

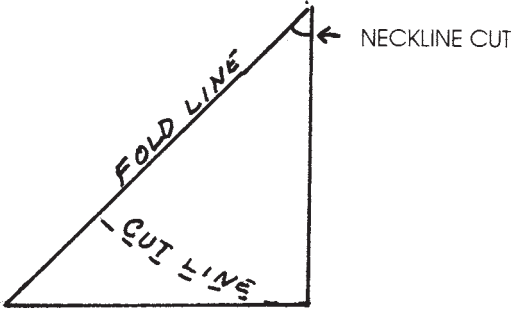

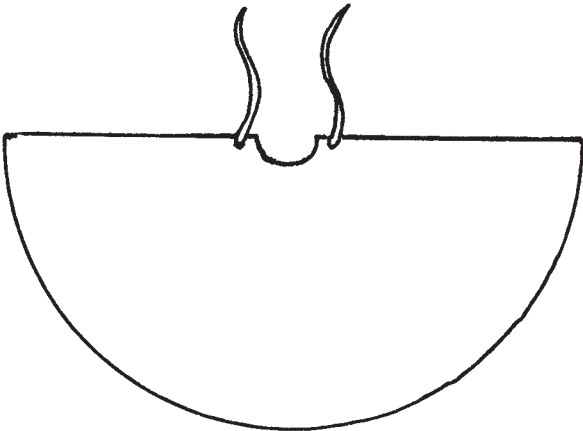
CAPE DIAGRAM #1
