

# ST. NICHOLAS MITER

## MATERIALS:

White or red poster board  
Gold poster board or cardstock  
Gold trimming or laces  
Craft glue

## EQUIPMENT:

Scissors  
Stapler



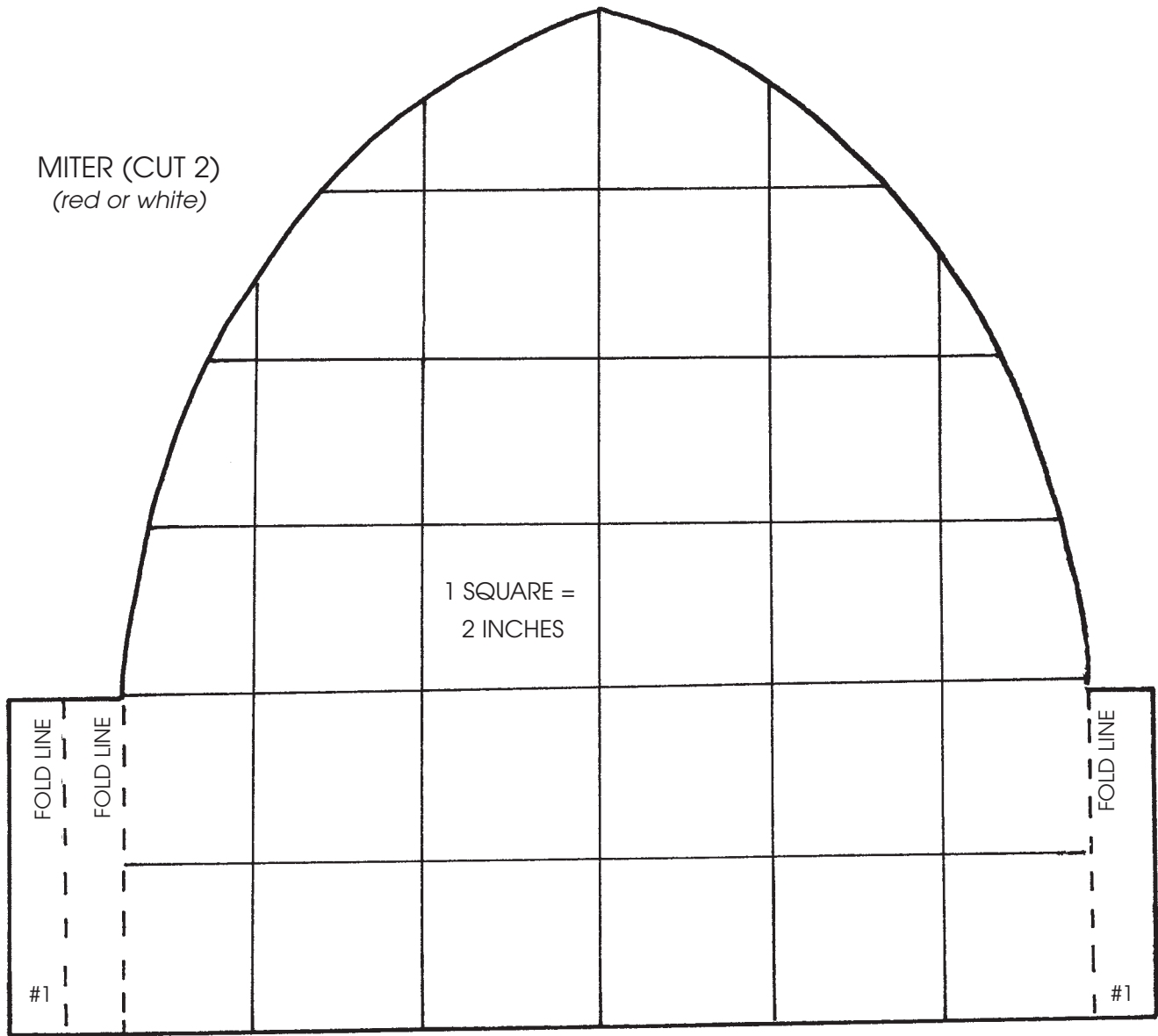
## DIRECTIONS:

1. Enlarge miter and miter band pattern 200%.  
When actual size, the squares in the miter pattern will measure 2 inches square.
2. Cut out pieces. For each miter cut 2 miter pieces from red or white; 2 head band pieces and 1 cross (choose which cross you want to use) from gold.
3. Fold the tabs on each side of the miter back on the fold line. Fold half of the larger tab forward on the middle fold line (this will make a pleat when assembled).
4. Take both sections of the hat and staple the two #1 sections together on each side. The first single side #1 over the #1 double side. Staple in three places to hold. Repeat on the other side. This helps in fitting the miter to the head of the person wearing the miter.
5. Decorate (see photo). Staple trim around sides first. Glue gold band. Glue cross on the front. Let dry before gluing other side. The white miter shows lace stapled to top of the band (optional).

*Miter band should be 11 1/4 x 1 1/2 inches when enlarged*

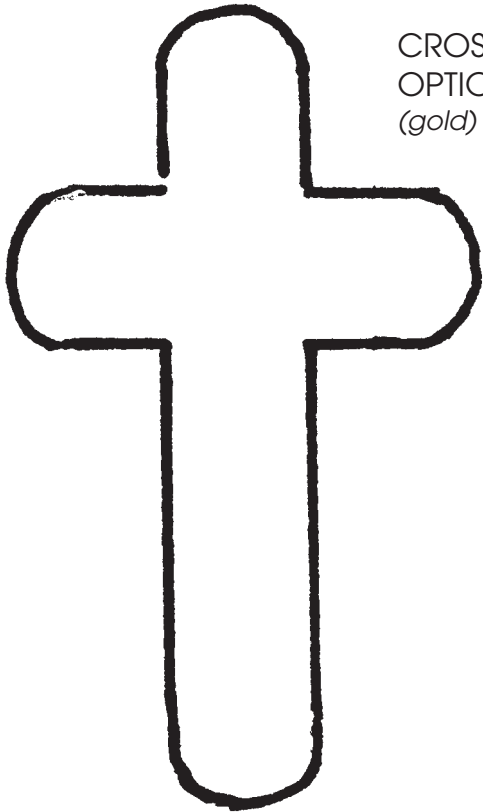


MITER BAND  
(CUT 2)

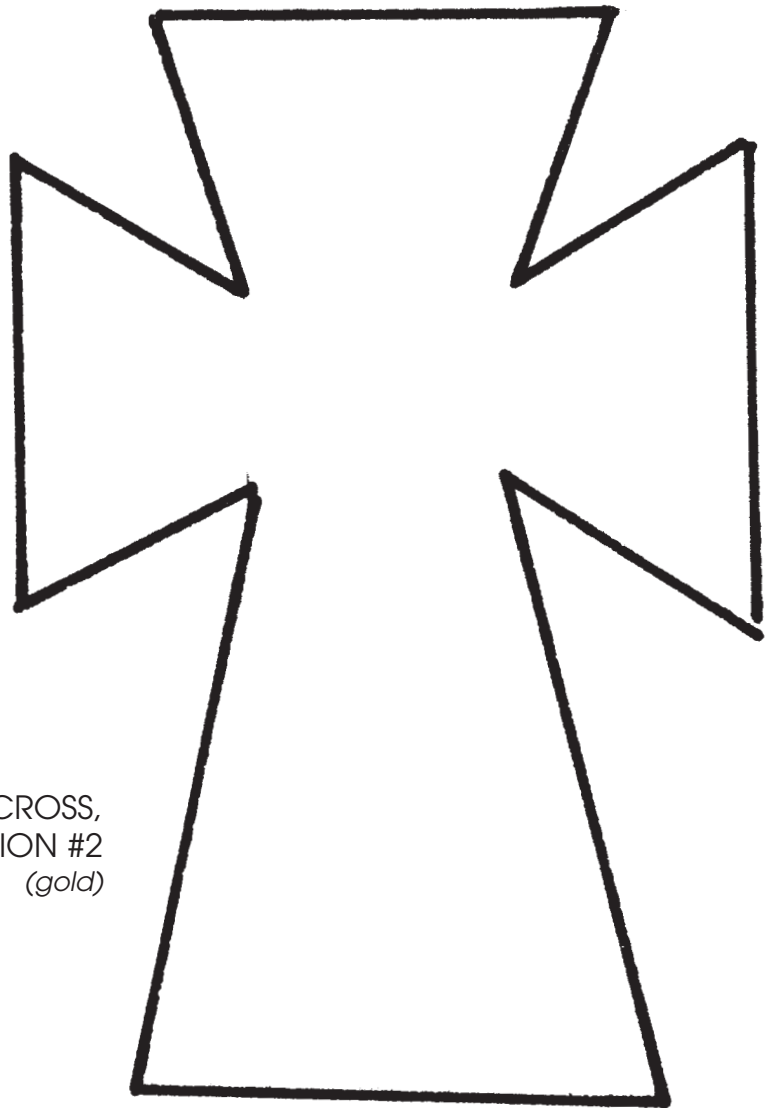
