

ST. NICHOLAS MOBILE

MATERIALS:

Pink, white, red, and yellow construction or fadeless paper, or cardstock

Red or white string or perle cotton

Black fine-point marker or pen

Craft glue

EQUIPMENT:

Scissors

DIRECTIONS:

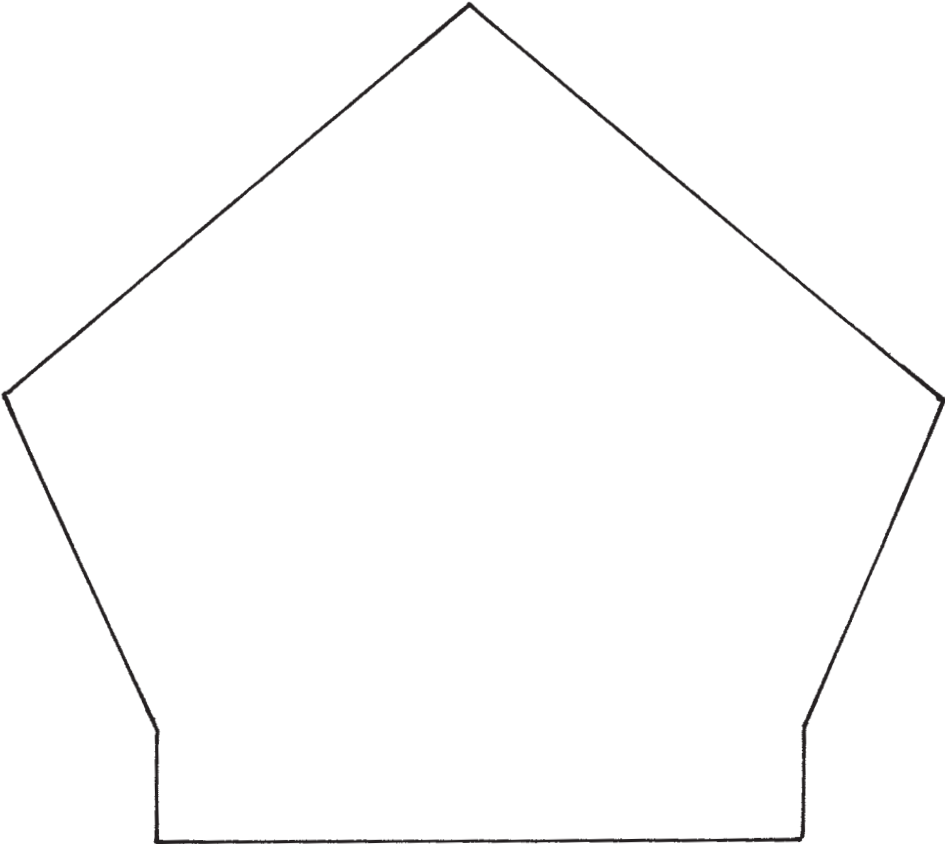
1. If desired, enlarge pattern.
2. Transfer patterns to construction paper and cut out all pieces.
Cut 2 pieces of each pattern piece.
3. Glue one set of pieces together as shown on the pattern. Let dry.
Do the same for the second set.
4. With black marker or pen, draw sides of face and eyes on both sets.
5. Take one set of 3 sections and lay it face down, leaving the desired space between each section.
This will probably be about $1/4$ to $1/2$ inch or more, depending on how large you made the design.
6. Cut a piece of string long enough to go from the middle of the beard to the top of the miter (hat), plus enough to make a loop for hanging. Tape the string down, making sure it goes up the center of the piece. Be sure and include the top loop and tape it down also
7. Glue the other sections on the back of the sections with the taped string so you have a double-sided piece. Dry thoroughly. You now have a St. Nicholas mobile.



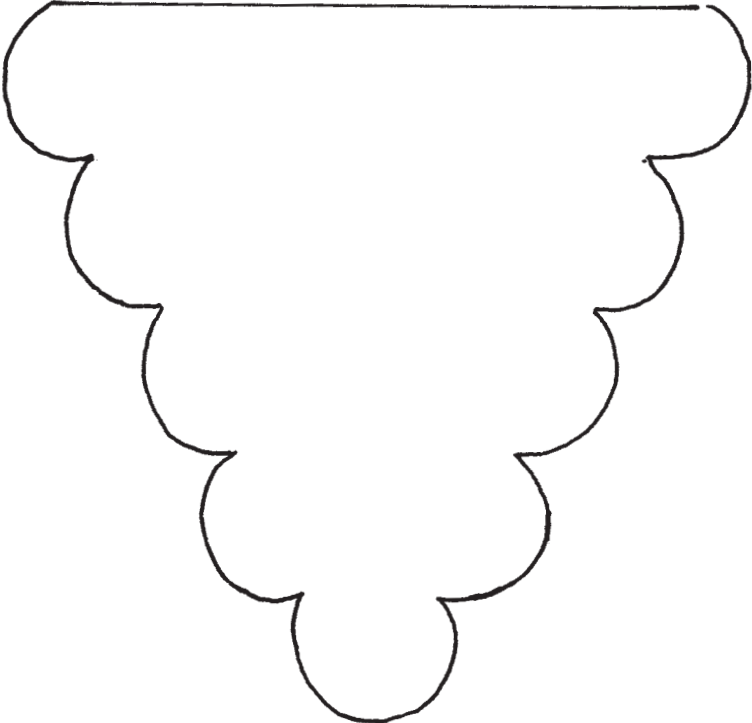

(red)

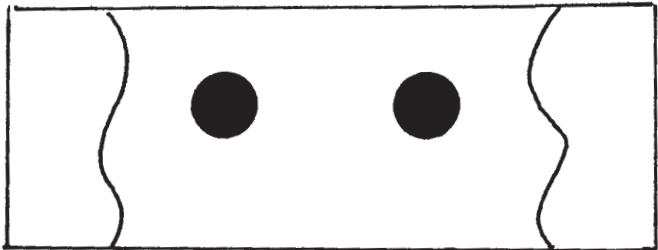


BEARD (CUT 2)

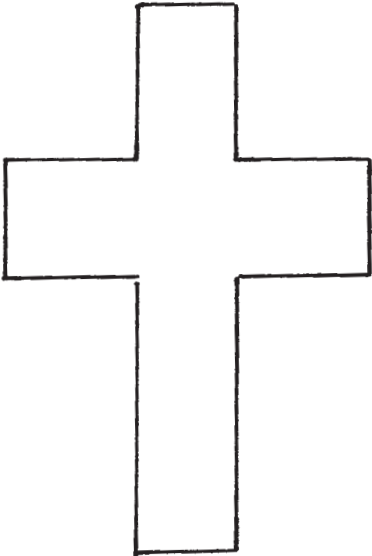
MITER BAND (CUT 2)
