

# ST. NICHOLAS

## PAPER NAPKIN MITER

### MATERIALS:

Red paper napkin (the size napkin determines the size of the miter)  
Yellow felt or construction paper  
Craft glue or roll-on dry adhesive

### EQUIPMENT:

Scissors

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Unfold paper napkin on table in front of you.
2. Take each corner to center of napkin, as in diagram #1 and fold it so the corner goes to the center of the napkin. Do all four corners. You will have formed a square.
3. Fold one point to the opposite corner forming a triangle, as in diagram #2.
4. Take left corner of triangle to the right about 1 1/2 inch past center. Keep fold along bottom, as in diagram #3. Do right hand corner to the left in the same way.
5. Take one folded corner and put it inside the other corner, as in diagram #4.
6. Cut cross out of yellow felt or construction paper. Put a tiny dab of glue on the back center of the cross. Place in position on front of miter.
7. You may put a small surprise (candy, etc.) inside the top point of the miter.  
If the miter is large enough, you could even put in a small tangerine or clementine.

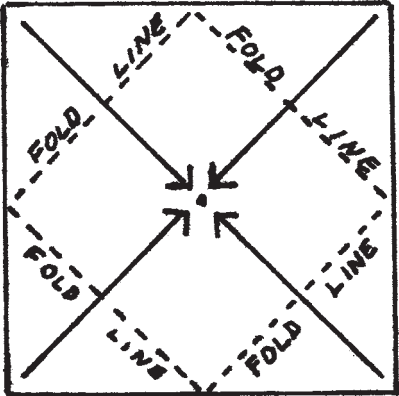

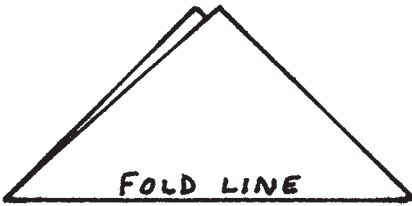

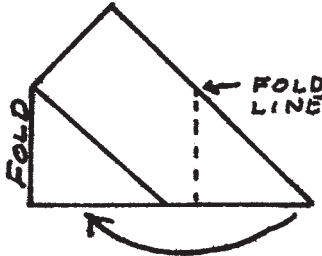

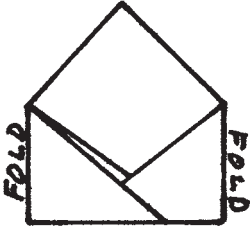
