

# ST. NICHOLAS STICK ORNAMENT

## MATERIALS:

White poster board, cardstock, or construction paper

Paint, markers, or crayons, for coloring

Gold 3-D scribe paint

Craft glue

1 flat craft stick, 3/4 x 6 inches

Gold ribbon

Black fine-point marker or pen (needed if pattern isn't copied by machine)

## EQUIPMENT:

Scissors

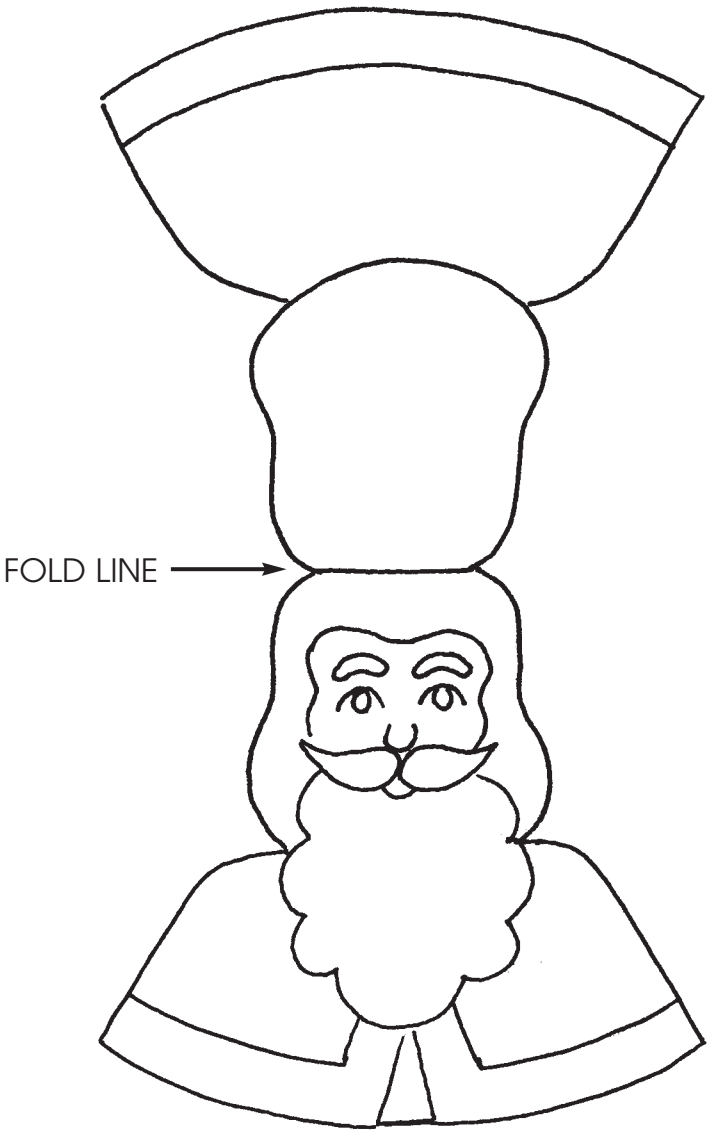
Paper punch

## DIRECTIONS:

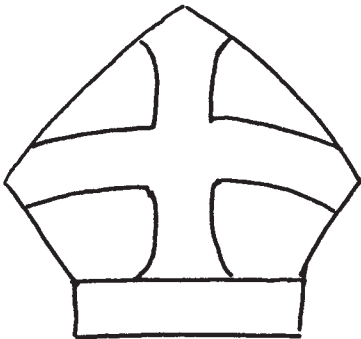
1. Paint craft stick whatever color you choose. Set aside to dry.
2. Transfer pattern to poster board, cardstock or construction paper (if you use cardstock, this can be done with a printer or copy machine).
3. Color design. Let dry.
4. Cut out head and miter (hat).
5. Fold head part over one end of craft stick (with the stick at the top of the head). Glue one side to the stick first, then glue the other side. Let dry.
6. Glue miter to the top of the head (see picture for positioning), then glue on the miter back. Let dry.
7. Decorate the piece (one side at a time) with 3-D scribe paint. Let the first side dry thoroughly before doing the other.
8. Paint name vertically on stick with 3-D scribe paint. Let dry thoroughly.
9. Punch hole in top of miter and put ribbon through to hang.
