

SVATY MIKULÁŠ

Czech St. Nicholas

Svaty Mikuláš descends from heaven on a golden cord held by angels, as he returns to earth for his gift-giving rounds each year.

MATERIALS:

White and blue lightweight poster board or cardstock
Bright gold paint, marker, or crayon
Black fine point marker or crayon
9-inch piece gold metallic cord or braid
9-inch piece gold ribbon
Craft glue or roll-on dry adhesive

EQUIPMENT:

Scissors
Paper punch



DIRECTIONS:

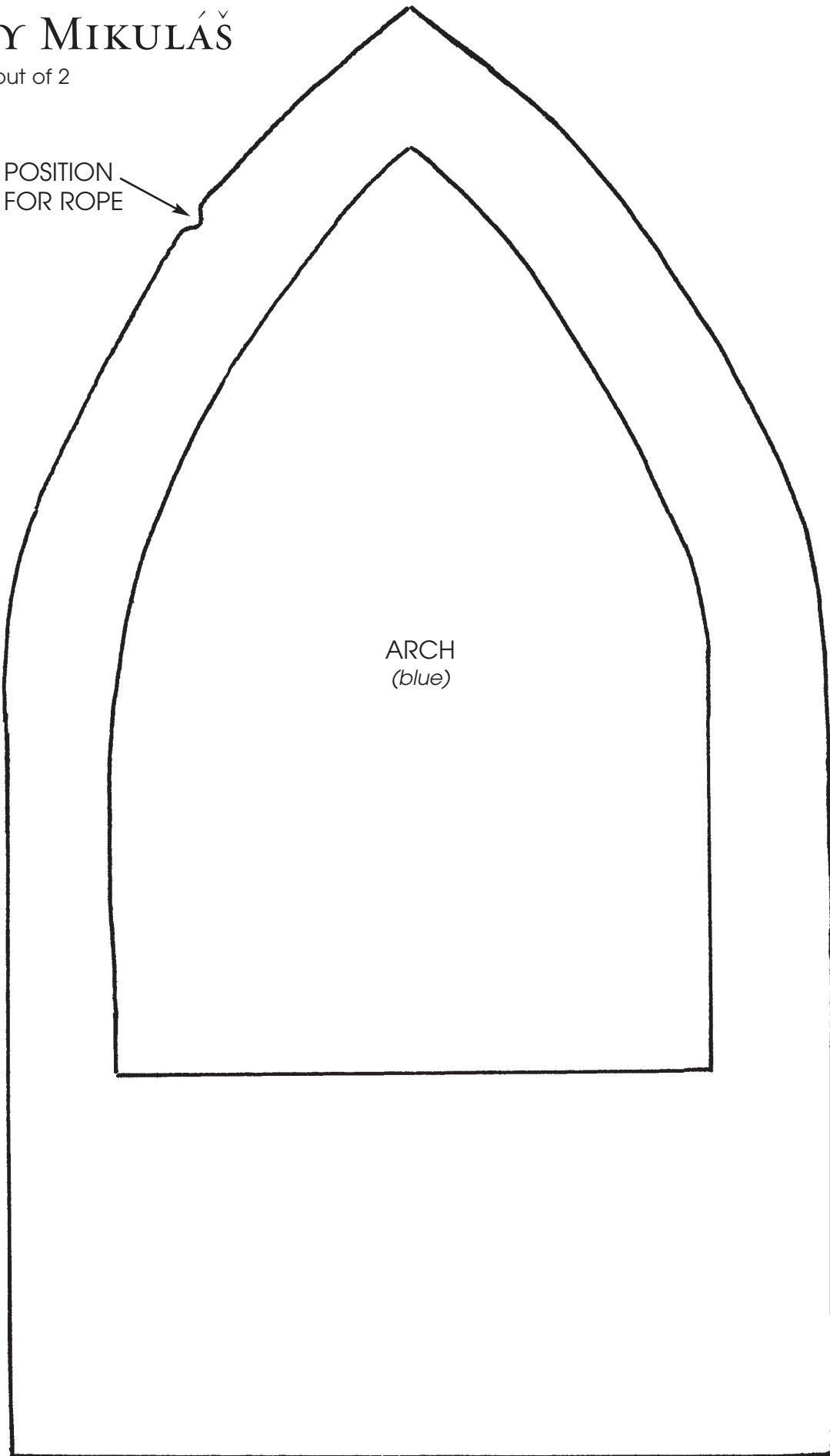
1. Color or paint the figure. Cut out pattern pieces (the patterns for the figure and crozier may be printed or copied on white cardstock, the arch on blue, one for each project). It is easier to transfer the pattern for the figure and crozier (staff) onto a piece of poster board and then paint or color them before cutting them out.
2. Color shoes with black marker or crayon.
3. Glue cloud into place and let dry.
4. Glue Svaty Mikuláš (St. Nicholas) into place and let dry.
5. Glue crozier into place and let dry.
6. Tape one end of gold cord on back of arch at place designated on pattern. Flip over on to front of arch. Tie a knot in other end of cord (in the same position as in the finished product photo). Glue to hand at appropriate spot and let knotted end hang loose. Let dry.
7. Punch a hole in top of arch, put ribbon through the hole to hang.

If you prefer a standard St. Nicholas, just omit the notch and the golden cord.
