

ST. NICHOLAS

WOODEN SHOE DECORATION

MATERIALS:

Yellow cardstock, poster board, or construction paper
Red and green construction paper
Red and green 3-D scribble paint
12-inch ribbon
Black or dark green marker
Red felt
Craft glue
Candy cane or other small treats

EQUIPMENT:

Paper punch
Scissors

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut yellow backing out of cardstock or poster board.
2. Cut out St. Nicholas miter (hat). You can either cut center cross out and let yellow backing show through, or cut separate yellow cross and glue onto miter. Glue miter to yellow backing (see photo for positioning).
3. Cut holly leaves out of green construction paper. Glue in position. Draw in vein lines with black or dark green marker.
4. Cut wooden shoe out of red felt. Put a bead of glue around edge of back of shoe, except for the top space where a foot would go in. Glue in position on yellow backing. Let dry.
5. With green 3-D scribble paint, draw decorative line on shoe, as shown.
6. With red 3-D scribble paint, draw or dab in 3 berries by leaves, as shown. Let all paint dry 2–4 hours.
7. Punch a hole in position indicated for hanging and tie ribbon to hang.
8. Put a candy cane for St. Nicholas' crozier (or other small treats) into the shoe.



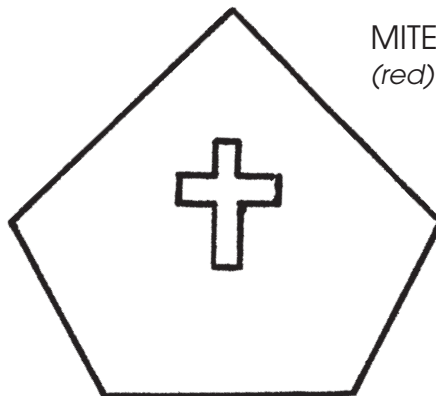

Pattern 1 out of 2

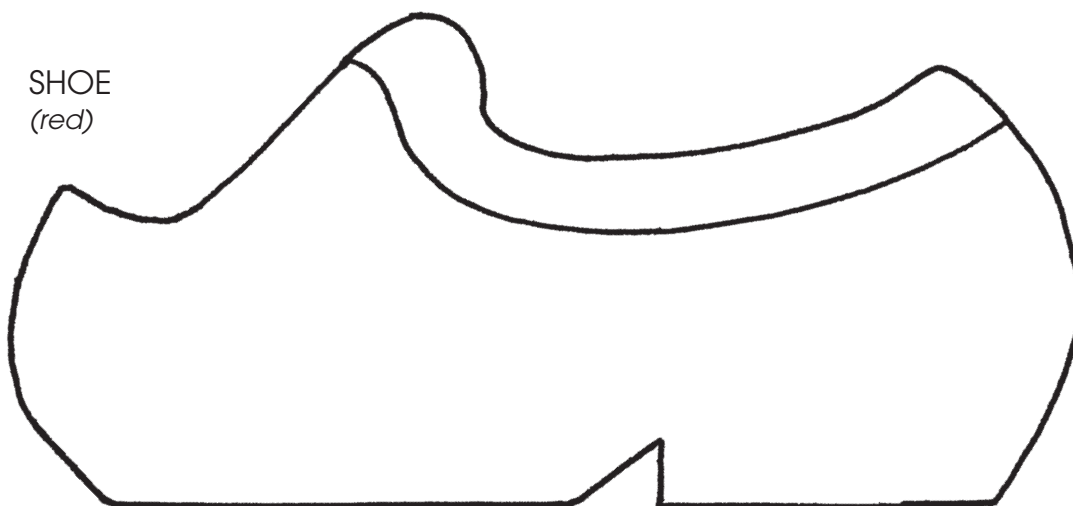
HOLLY

(red)

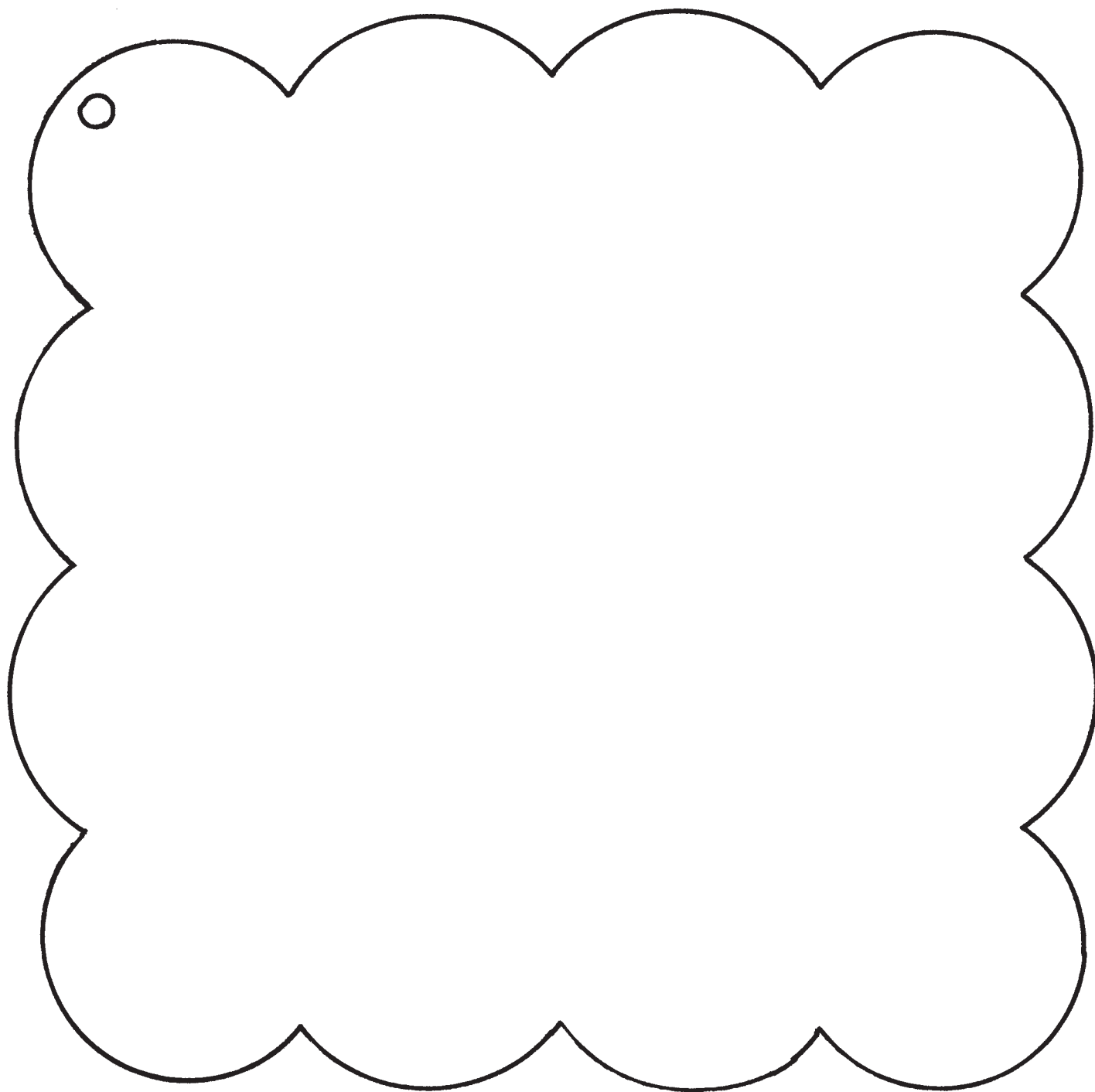


SHOE
