The candle is lit

Suffer to redeem our loss. Alleluia!

Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Alleluia!

ADULT: *Pouring water on seed*

Let this water remind us that this Easter we
have been born anew to a living hope through
the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

Pour water again

Let this water remind us of our baptism, when
we were born again.

CHILD: This is the day which the Lord has made. We
will rejoice and be glad in it.

ALL: **The earth is full of the goodness of the
Lord. By the Word of the Lord, the heavens
were made.**

CHILD: Sing to the Lord a new song, for he has done
marvelous things.

ALL: **Make a joyful noise to God, all the earth.
Sing the glory of his name. Clap your
hands, all you people. Shout to God with
the voice of triumph.**

ADULT: Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his
steadfast love endures forever. **Amen.**
